Council Updates

• President

- i. Apparel Sale
 - a. The sale went well and we outsold previous years with an estimated profit of around \$2000. In total, we sold 126 pieces of apparel. Of those, 44 were customized. The apparel is expected to arrive on February 2nd.
 - b. We will likely be holding another apparel sale in late February or March, however, we will not be selling the same items as the previous one. We will be working on getting backpacks and spring jackets/windbreakers.

ii. MMI Video

a. Prof. Crandall has approached us for ideas regarding the MMI welcome video for candidates this year. In the past, council has traditionally taken control of filming the video but this year, we would like to reach out to the rest of the class. We will most likely form a committee to organize (max. 12 people) the filming and planning of the video.

iii. UPS Meeting

a. A UPS meeting was held on Jan. 23rd, 2018. The main focuses of the meeting were updates from everyone and the changing of the Constitution. The only relevant point for us is that Phrosh next school year will be chaired not only by the Second Year Vice-President, but also the President.

• Vice President

- i. Charity Week Money
 - a. Will be writing a cheque to Me to We soon now that we have received our share of the Charity Week sales.

Secretary

- i. Financial Update
 - a. We have received a \$6000 cheque from UPS (Charity Week money + student fees) and made \$4478 in total from the apparel sales. We are currently sitting at about \$9250.
- ii. Valentine's Day Matchmaking
 - a. This is currently an idea in progress. While most members are in favour of holding events where students can meet each other, it would be preferable to take the romantic aspect out of it. Yifan and Gigi will be coming up with an alternative proposal for this.

Social Rep

- i. PharmAssassins
 - a. PharmAssassins was a big success. 69 people signed up and now there are less than 20 people left in the game.
- ii. Other Events
 - a. Many people have been asking whether we will be organizing a ski trip during reading week. It's a great idea, however, planning it at this time is not feasible as most groups usually start planning in October. This is definitely something we can look into for next year.
 - b. Dance Cave 2.0 (Jan 26th)
 - o There will be another Dance Cave event on January 26th in collaboration with the 2T0s & 1T9s.
 - c. Toronto Lights Fest
 - o Perhaps this could be an idea for an event in the next few weeks.

CAPSI Reps

- i. PDW
 - a. There was not much turnout from the 2T1s with 7 of us going but it was understandable as many people weren't aware of what PDW was like. To promote this, a 2T1 Snapchat account was made to show what the events were like. The Snapchat account can be used by council members to promote council events in the future.
 - b. We won Pharmafacts!
- ii. CAPSI National Elections
